The following format and content of the price list has been stipulated by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario and is required to be posted by all bereavement licensees.

## DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES AND FEES

Any services marked with an asterisk (\*) are the minimum services required to carry out a direct burial, cremation, or hydrolysis.

**\* Professional and staff services (for Minimum Services) .....\$395.00**

Professional consultation with licensed personnel, including but not limited to expert advice on options to meet your needs, drafting notices, and advice regarding possible government benefits. Coordination of all activities before, during and after they have been provided by us, and those provided by third-party suppliers, such as the cemetery, crematorium, and media outlets (death notices). Also included are overhead expenses such as maintenance and utilities, accounting and office administration, insurance and 24-hour access to emergency assistance.

**\* Documentation .....\$355.00**

Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate, cremation application or interment permission form. Third-party fees charged for these documents are not included and are itemized below on page 3. We also provide 12 Proof of Death certificates for estate settlement purposes. Proof of Death certificates are provided to the deceased's authorized representative as a service only and are not a legal government document; however, they are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes. Should you require additional copies there will be no additional fees. Sometimes a provincial "Certified Death Certificate" will be necessary and is available for purchase from the Office of the Registrar General, or through us as a disbursement.

## FACILITIES

**\* Facilities for preparation/shelter .....\$365.00**

A secure and private room used to prepare and/or shelter the body until the time of burial, cremation, or alternative disposition. Identification may also take place in this room. This charge applies whenever the body is in our facility. If the body is to be held in our facility beyond a period of 2 days, a daily body storage fee of \$70.00 may apply.

**\* Minimum preparation of remains (requires "Facilities for preparation/shelter") .....N/C**

\* This service is a minimum requirement. The body is checked for personal effects (which will be returned to the authorized representative, unless otherwise instructed) and placed into the casket selected.

## TRANSPORTATION

**\* Initial transfer of remains .....\$385.00**

Vehicle with 2 trained staff and specialized equipment used to transfer remains into our care from the place of death or Coroner's Office, hospital, airport, etc. Additional mileage fees apply beyond 50 km.

**\* Final transfer of remains**

Vehicle and one staff to transfer the deceased to the final place of disposition ( there is N/C for an additional staff.....N/C up to 50 km radius

**Additional mileage**.....\$1.50

Charge per kilometer (one way) for use of any vehicle over a 50 km radius

**OTHER SERVICES AND SUPPLIES**

**\* Removal of pacemakers or other implants** .....N/C

This procedure is mandatory prior to cremating a body that has a pacemaker or other implant and must be carried out by a licensed funeral director. Includes disposal of device. If a person was undergoing brachytherapy (radioactive theraseeds) or radioisotope treatments before death, it is possible that the deceased may not be able to be cremated; please speak with our funeral director for more information.

**Refundable Deposit for Cremated Remains** .....\$350.00

When human remains are to be cremated, payment of a refundable deposit may be required. If the cremated remains are not claimed within one year of the cremation, the deposit may be used to inter the cremated remains in common ground in a cemetery of the funeral home’s choosing. If the cremated remains are claimed before they are interred, the deposit will be refunded.

**DISBURSEMENTS**

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by the transfer service to third party providers. Any prices quoted in this section are subject to change without notice. Such items include but are not limited to:

**Cremation fee** .....\$ 621.50 tax incld

This fee is charged by the crematorium for the cremation of the body. Passages - End of Life Services recommends Bayview Cemetery, crematory & mausoleum, put the purchaser is welcome to choose which crematorium provides the cremation service. The fee varies by crematorium.

**Coroner’s fee** .....\$75

This is a provincially set fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation or alternative disposition or ‘Out of Province’ shipping to take place.

**Interment fee** .....\$ varies

This fee is charged by the cemetery for the opening and closing of the grave. The fee varies by cemetery and by the size and depth of the grave.

**Municipal death registration fee** .....\$ 20

This is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death on behalf of the Province of Ontario. The municipality issues a burial permit, then forwards the registration documents to the Office of the Registrar General in Thunder Bay.

**Media notices** .....\$ varies

These are charges for death notices in newspapers, radio stations or other media outlets. These fees are the actual cost from the outlet and will have no additional fees added.

**What is NOT included in the above Minimum Services charge:**

- any supplies, such as a casket, outer burial container, urn, etc.
- any additional services that may be selected, such as pallbearers for interment
- additional mileage fees beyond 50 km
- pacemaker / radioactive implant removal, if applicable
- applicable taxes (HST)
- disbursements to be paid to third parties on your behalf, such as the cemetery interment fee, crematorium fee, coroner’s fee, death registration fee, etc. (as described on pages 2 and 3)

**Minimum required disbursements, as applicable:**

**Cremation fee** charged by crematorium:.....\$621.50 tax incld  
(We will arrange cremation with any crematorium, but we suggest Bayview Crematorium...)

**Coroner’s fee** (required for cremation/alkaline hydrolysis/out of province shipments only):.....\$75

**Interment fee** charged by the cemetery to open and close the grave:.....Price varies by cemetery

**Death registration fee** charged by the local municipality:.....\$20  
(charged in all cases where the death occurs in Ontario)

**ADDITIONAL SERVICE OPTIONS**

**Transportation services to and from a location of a family-led visitation and/or funeral service**

Although a Transfer Service Operator – Class 1 is prohibited by law from arranging, conducting or participating in a visitation, or funeral service at which human remains are present, it may offer transportation services to and from a location of a visitation or service that is led by the family.

**CASKETS**

The following caskets listed are those generally available. Additional options are available upon request. Unless otherwise noted, all caskets listed are standard adult size.

**Minimum requirements for a casket:**

For cremation: A body must be presented to the crematorium in a rigid, leak-proof casket that is made of a combustible material, such as wood or cardboard. Caskets containing non-flammable, hazardous material or chlorinated or fibre-reinforced plastic, other than incidental metal, cannot be used for cremation.

The following caskets are suitable for cremation: Note - dependant on physical dimensions it is occasionally necessary to provide an oversized casket, in these instances prices will vary.

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## URNS, KEEPSAKE URNS & URN VAULTS

You are not required to purchase an urn, keepsake urn or an urn vault. When a body is cremated or hydrolyzed, the remaining cremated / hydrolyzed remains will be presented in a box that is suitable for interment or scattering as is. Passages - End of Life Services does not stock urns, jewelry, and keepsakes. Nonetheless, should you desire an urn or keepsake we will recommend and guide you to a on-line purchase. Please speak with one of our licensees for assistance.

## PAYMENT, FINANCING & FUNDING

### **For services at time of death:**

Payment is due within 60 days of signing the contract, beyond which interest will be charged at a rate of 2%, which is equivalent to 24% per annum (APR). Payment may be made by cash, cheque, debit, and most major credit cards. All accounts outstanding after 1 year will be sent to collections.

Financial assistance for burial and cremation / hydrolysis services is available through various governmental agencies, to those who qualify.

### **Pre-payment in advance of need:**

For services that are being arranged pre-need, we offer a trust funding option when prepaying services or supplies through Guaranteed Funeral Deposits of Canada ( GFD )

**Trust:** You pay for the services and supplies at today's price and we will place your money in a trust account, where it will accrue interest until the prepaid contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered). Pre-payment can be made by cash, cheque or credit. Funds are held in the purchaser's name.

**Guarantee:** When paid in full in accordance with the payment terms set out in the prepaid contract, the prepaid contract is guaranteed. The total payment(s) made plus interest / growth earned will be applied to the future price of the services and supplies. If the total payment(s) plus interest / growth earned are insufficient to cover the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies, we will absorb the difference as a loss. Any funds in excess of the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies will be returned or applied toward additional services, supplies and disbursements purchased at the time of need, as applicable. Conditions apply. Any changes to the prepaid contract may result in the prepaid contract being null and void and a new contract being executed with current pricing at the time changes are made.
